The move from town has left me without a "full service" shop but most minor repairs I can do here at home. The thing I miss the most is my spray booth. However I hope to have a shop out here in the near future. In the mean time, I have re-established my dealerships and have added some new and exciting products that will be available to you at very reasonable costs. Some examples are D'Addario and GHS strings, Rocktron amplifiers (which are rapidly climbing to the top of the guitar amp pile), Fishman products, Evans drum accessories, Planet Waves music accessories ([capo for \\$15](#), [tuner/metronome for \\$45](#)) and more! I am also in the process of adding products and a shopping cart to my web-site. I have more work to do but that could make things very easy for you to make purchases. Any requests for products that I don't carry are welcome as well, let me know what you would like me to get for you, and I'll see what I can do.

I have included some photos for you to look at. The top photo is showing the top of a guitar that I built being glued on. I believe this is the guitar that Corky Heidler purchased from me before he moved "up north." The middle photo is of a green-sunburst, hollow-body strat, with gold trimmings that I built for David Dix. The photo does not do this instrument justice. The bottom photo is of a 70's Vega guitar made in the Netherlands. This guitar is a favorite of Nathan George's and has seen many repairs by me over the years. The photo below is of the neck jig which holds the neck in position (as if the strings were on) to re-fret and/or level frets.
